Historic ship with royal connections and an endless array of hosting possibilities

A piece of seafaring history

Time has stood still on board former steamship the Hydrograaf.

Thanks to its distinguished seafaring past, the Hydrograaf is almost perfectly preserved. The original interior, resplendent with deep-red padauk panelling, shining brass, painted decorations and deepbuttoned furniture, speaks of old world skills and craftsmanship, and evokes turn-of-the-century elegance and comfort.

As royal yacht, the Hydrograaf below flies the Royal Standard Flag to signal the Queen or members of the royal family are on board.



Sailing area

Home port: Weesp (Amsterdam)

The ship sails out from her home port in Weesp which is within reach of most charter ports in Western Europe.

International

The Hydrograaf is a very safe and sea-worthy ship, and is equally suited for inland waters as well as the open European seas. She can be chartered from most ports in the Netherlands, France, Germany and Belgium.



Exterior

The spacious upper deck with optional outdoor bar and the ample seating on the promenade deck below, make the Hydrograaf the perfect venue for all forms of entertaining and hospitality corporate and private - and the ideal setting for weddings and anniversaries.






Interior

The wood-panelled saloon on the promenade deck has several open dining areas, including the classic u-shaped lounge. The lobby area downstairs has additional seating/dining arrangements both port and starboard. The dance floor next to the Queen Wilhelmina bar at the very bottom of the ship can also be used as a private dining room











Number of seats outside: 70
